Below is a list of pertinent information, which will make this evening proceed smoothly. Please review this list with your graduate then complete and sign the permission form.

- 1. This permission form must be legibly completed and signed by student and parent/guardian then submitted with balance paid in full by May 15, 2015. This applies to all students, even if you are 18 years old.
- 2. Project Graduation is a drug, alcohol, smoke, and tobacco free environment. Throughout the entire event, all Board of education policies regarding substance abuse and smoking will be in full effect. Any individuals found to be in violation of school rules, including those involving alcohol/drugs will be handled according to school policy. No smoking is permitted inside or outside the facilities. Students will not be admitted if it is suspected that they may be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Use of any of these substances during the event will result in immediate removal and the parent/guardian will be notified to pick up the student(s) involved.
- 3. By signing the permission you agree to save and hold harmless the Board of Education of New Milford, its agents, servants, administrators, and the Project Graduation Steering Committee from any and all liability arising out of the event.
- 4. Students will respect the event venues and do no malicious damage. In the event of a student's inappropriate behavior, he/she will be removed from the event and the parent/guardian will be notified to pick up the student.
- 5. Pack a bag which will include sweats, shorts, t-shirt, sneakers, bathing suit, towel, as well as personal care items. DO NOT bring any expensive audio/video equipment or jewelry items. Project Graduation and the venues **WILL NOT** be responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- 6. All bags must be labeled with the graduate's name and dropped off at the NMHS auditorium by 9:00 am on June 24th (All bags will be inspected).
- 7. NO ONE will be permitted on the bus without a signed permission slip and fees for the event paid in full.
- 8. The buses will depart from Paramus Catholic High School approximately 30 minutes after the completion of the Graduation ceremony. No food or beverages will be permitted on the bus. All personal belongings such as purses, backpacks, etc. will be inspected.
- 9. The bus will return to New Milford High School at approximately 6:00 am following morning, June 25, 2015.
